Billericay	Rhythm Stick	4.8	Amber	Hoppy, rich ale with caramel flavours.
Billericay	Sex, Drugs & Rock & Roll	5	IPA	Brewed with 3 US hops added three times during the brewing process
Billericay	Sun Corner Gold	3.9	Golden	Crisp refreshing golden ale dry hopped with Cascade and Chinook hops.
Billericay	Zeppelin	3.8	Pale	Easy drinking session ale with slight smoky notes.
Bishop Nick	Divine	5.1	Brown	This ale is a nod to a classic Ridley's recipe. A festival of English flavours featuring spice, nuttiness and caramel, nicely balanced with a mellow hoppiness. Pours dark amber with a deliciously dense creamy head and a warming malt aroma.
Brentwood	BBC1	1.5	Amber	Low alcohol. Loads of flavours bursting on the palate from the mix of Columbus, Chinook, Citra & Cascade hops
Brentwood	Brentwood Best	4.2	Amber	Made with a good dose of Challenger and EKG hops giving a well rounded flavour and aroma
Brentwood	Chipping Chirper	5.2	Amber	No tasting notes available. Brewed with the help of Ongar dads from Chipping Ongar Primary School Association (COPSA),
Brentwood	Summer Virgin	4.5	Golden	A light golden beer with citrus notes and aromatic hops giving a range of fruit flavours.
Brixton	Effra Ale	4.5	Amber	A fresh and feisty amber ale fusing a rich malt base with a complex blend of hops
Brockley	Brockley Pale	4.1	Pale	A full-bodied malt driven pale ale bittered with a combination of British hops giving an initial bittersweet taste, followed by hints of apricot, leading to a satisfying finish
Brockley	Red Ale	4.8	Red	European malts hitched with American hops for a mid-Atlantic brew, rich in flavour with a deep reddish tone and a definitive bold dry finish
Bullfinch	Swift	4	Pale	A hoppy spring ale. Bitter and light
Colchester	Brazilian	4.6	Porter	Coffee and vanilla porter beautifully balanced
Colchester	Cat's Whiskers Cream Stout	4.8	Stout	Very smooth drinking cream stout. Slight sweetness, full bodied.
Colchester	Jack Spitty's Smuggler's Ale	4	Golden	Easy drinking summer ale. Delicate bitterness and light aroma.

Crouch Vale	Chinook	4	Pale	Not quite the bitter grapefruit bomb of last year but still a super tart clean and very pale beer
Dominion	Wheat Beer	4.5	Speciality	Brewed with a high percentage of malted wheat, and a true wheat beer yeast, this beer has the classic Belgian wheat beer flavours of vanilla and orange peel.
Dominion	Woodbine Racer	4.2	Golden	A golden ale with sweet malt and citrus flavours, and a tropical fruit aroma of clematines and passion fruit.
East London Brewery	Foundation	4.2	Bitter	An amber best bitter, with good balance of maltiness, marmalade notes and a crisp, bitter finish.
East London Brewery	Orchid	3.6	Mild	Award-winning and one of the few Milds currently brewed in London. Deeply satisfying, yet delicate with hints of vanilla giving added complexity.
Elephant School	Lager than Life	4.6	Lager	Crisp and refreshing Kolsch style lager
Elephant School	Mango Unchained	7.2	Speciality	Double IPA brewed with mangos and strong hop flavours
Enefield	London Porter	5.5	Porter	Roasted malts with chocolate, caramel, coffee and liquorice. Dark fruits and berries!
Enefield	Raspberry Pale	3.8	Speciality	Flavoured with raspberries for a summer glow.
Farmer's Ales	Pucks Folly	4.2	Golden	East Kent Goldings hops gives this a spicy character with pineapple on the aroma and taste (some say grapefruit!)
Farmer's Ales	Sundrift	5	Wheat	A new summer wheat beer, light and refreshing
Five Points Brewing Co	Pale	4.4	Pale	A fresh, zesty, aromatic pale ale brewed with malted barley, a little wheat, and Amarillo and Citra hops from the West Coast of the USA. The British ale tradition collides head first with the best of the US craft beer movement, resulting in an incredibly drinkable Pale Ale with tonnes of US hop aroma and flavour.
Five Points Brewing Co	Railway Porter	4.8	Porter	A Porter in the classic London style with our own twist. Aromas of chocolate and coffee with hints of caramel, brewed with British East Kent Goldings hops.
Five Points Brewing Co	XPA	4	Pale	Juicy and tropical, even paler and hoppier than our flagship Five Points Pale. Dry hopped with Citra and Galaxy hops. This beer started life as our Five Points & Field Day collab Beer 'Ten Points Pale', brewed for Field Day Music Festival 2016, and we loved it so much that we added it to our core range.
George's	Cockleboats BB	4	Brown	Deep copper coloured brew using 5 malts, some German. Two american hop varieties make this a palate filling session ale
Hackney	American Pale Ale	4.5	Pale	A lighter variation on our favourite transatlantic style that dates back to the early 1980's. This beer has a rich malt base giving it a warm amber colour and a delicious body of flavour. It is brewed with high quality American aroma hops that make it refreshing and hoppy.
Hackney	Kapow!	4.5	Pale	a big juicy fruit hop character with pineapple in the finish. Chinook, Centennial and Equanot hops.
Harwich Town	Mostly Mosaic	4	Amber	Gloriously hoppy amber ale. Lashings of Mosaic, Citra and Centennial hops added at the end of the boil give a mouthwatering juiciness

Hop Monster	Gaspar's Star	8.6	Speciality	A complex strong ale crafted with a mix of crystal and smoked malts. Hopped with a huge amount of Comet and Columbus hops to reach 119 IBUs! Then finished off with an Abbey Ale yeast to provide the alcohol warmth.
Hope Brewery	Back in Black	4.3	Speciality	It starts life like an IPA using just pale and crystal malts. Black malt is cold-steeped to extract the colour but not the typical roast flavour of black malt, this cold-steeping liquor is then added to the brew kettle after the main mash and sparge. The pale IPA then becomes black. It is hopped with marynka and perle hops.
Hope Brewery	Summer Gold	4.3	Golden	a refreshing, golden ale brewed with 100% pale malt and hopped with 100% brewer's gold hops.
Hope Brewery	SX Gremlin	4	Bitter	copper coloured, hoppy bitter. Brewed with pale and crystal malt with perle, marynka and brewer's gold hops.
Husk	Mandarin and Earl Grey IPA	5.5	IPA	Light malt base, loaded with Mandarina Bavaria, Jarillo and galaxy hops. Infused with Earl Grey tea.
Husk	Saison	6.1	Speciality	Belgium farmhouse beer. We kept it traditional with noble European and British hops. But we gave it a summery twist of ginger and juniper.
Keppels	Golden Crow	4	Golden	light golden ale that's hoppy and full of character.
Keppels	Tipsy Crow Stout	5	Stout	strong stout with a smokey flavour. Thin liquorice taste with a mild bitterness but won't leave a taste on the palate
Keppels	Two Crows	5.7	Old Ale	traditional old ale ruby red that's rich with a fruity undertone
Mauldons	Silver Adder	4.2	Bitter	A light coloured bitter with fine hop and malt combinations giving a refreshing crisp finish

Mighty Oak	Breakthrough	3.7	Blonde	A blonde Summer ale bursting with floral, citrus, herbal, lemon hop aroma and a satisfying wheat character
Mighty Oak	Red Sky	4.5	Ruby	A rich, ruby best bitter, with a burnt toffee maltiness and an orange fruitiness from the Summit hops.
Milton	Minotaur	3.3	Mild	A rich dark mild with bags of character from the lavish use of chocolate malt.

New River	Riverbed Red	4.2	Red	copper coloured ale: resinous, malty, earthy aroma; complex rich caramel flavours
One Mile End	Dockers Delight	4.2	Bitter	Classic English bitter with crystal malt and First Gold hops.
One Mile End	Juicy 4PM	4.9	Pale	A New England style IPA
One Mile End	Temperance Session	3.5	Pale	New recipe and re-brand. Hoppy session IPA with a substantial body for such low abv.
Pitfield	1850 London Porter	5	Porter	This is a black beer, with chocolate and dark malt flavours. It is brewed to a Whitbread recipe from 1850. In 2010 it won the Champion Bottled Beer of Britain Silver Award.

Pitfield	Eco Warrior	4.5	Pale	It is brewed with lager hops and ale yeast. It has a silky honeyed flavour up front, with a gentle bittersweet moreish citrus finish.
Pitfield	Pitfield Bitter	3.7	Bitter	This is our classic session beer. It was first brewed in the cellar of the Beer Shop 8 Pitfield Street NI, back in the early 1980's. It has a malty, nutty taste, and a dry bitter hop finish.
Pitfield	Whisky IPA	7	IPA	A true IPA. Big sweet malt flavours are balanced by a peppery bitter finish. Mouthwatering! good beer. Victorian recipe
Redemption	Big Chief	5.5	IPA	Big hoppy IPA style beer, packed full of Kiwi hops with hints of honey and nectar and plenty of tropical citrus and floral notes.
Redemption	Hopspur	4.5	Amber	Amber Ale with some citrus fruit aromas, chewy biscuity malt flavours, slight sticky sweetness and grapefruit piney hop flavours. Well balanced with hop flavours to the fore and an easy bitter finish. SIBA Gold Medal winner
Redemption	Redemption Pale Ale	3.8	Pale	Golden amber in colour with citrus and some floral hop aromas. Toffee sweetness and citrus fruit flavours are balanced by a floral and earthy hop contribution, with a long dry satisfying bitter finish.
Redemption	Rock the Kazbek	4	Blonde	Golden amber in colour with citrus and some floral hop aromas. Toffee sweetness and citrus fruit flavours are balanced by a floral and earthy hop contribution, with a long dry satisfying bitter finish.
Redemption	Urban Dusk	4.6	Bitter	Chestnut coloured Premium Bitter with malts providing coffee aromas and some hazelnut and caramel on the palate, while Bramling Cross hops offer some dark fruit flavours. Citrus notes and an earthy bitterness lasts into the finish.

Signature	Backstage IPA	5.6	IPA	It won't throw your tastebuds out of a hotel window, but it will keep you coming back. It encompasses the finest British Malts with some New Zealand hops that give a mouthfeel and taste that makes for the most interesting bitter you've ever had four of, and you'll probably be able to still lay down that bass hook afterwards.
Signature	Session	4	Bitter	Session is our homage to the humble session musician, slaving away for much less credit than their skill deserves. Brewed to stand the test of time, a solid 4/4 studio band playing perfectly on the beat that will impress you without you even noticing.
Silks	Molly's Jolly Mild	4	Mild	A dark and delicious mild with rich malts, smooth roast chocolate and coffee for a moreish mellow flavour
